

Physicians are looking for information online.


The results of Elsevier's global surveys of healthcare professionals show that physicians look to credible sources like medical journals to discover information about new products/developments in their field.



The most popular content is online medical journals; 84% of physicians globally use them to find out about developments in their field.




Almost all physicians read journals monthly, and almost one-third read them daily.



According to the survey of physicians, medical journals and books are in the top three most important sources of information online.


Physicians frequently read medical journals online and in print.



Globally, 96% of physicians say medical journals have 'some' or 'a lot of' influence over their practice and prescribing habits.




Medical journals affect the way physicians work and therefore impact patient care.

The top three sources globally for physicians prescribing drugs:






Globally, source credibility is the most important factor in physicians' choice of resources.





This is a long trend: credibility has held the top spot since the first annual survey was conducted in 2016.



It also supports your needs offline, so you can read or print the information you need even if you are offline – whether it's the abstract or full text article.




### Track your impact

With Article Service, you can get realtime information on how your content is being used. You can track the downloads and pageviews, see your top performing articles and journals, and find out about who's using your content.


